ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY NOTE:

In 1964, a group of Portlanders named Portland Listener Supported Radio connected with Lorenzo Milam for help organizing a new radio station. Milam, a former KPFA volunteer, agreed to help and after a series of meetings, Portland Listener Supported Radio applied for a license for a Portland radio station. Milam is also credited with helping other community radio stations around the country in a mini-network that was sometimes referred to as the "KRAB nebula". Milam, along with David Calhoun and Gray Haertig from KRAB in Seattle, helped KBOO organize their station. KBOO Community Radio was on the air in June of 1968 with a repeater signal from KRAB. The non-profit KBOO Foundation was founded in 1972 to independently support the KBOO station. Today KBOO has nearly 70,000 listeners, and over 6000 subscribing members. The station's goals are to make radio and information resources more accessible to the community and to provide free training to volunteers who keep KBOO on the air.

Collection Note:

A great percentage of the analog archive materials were recorded from broadcast onto different physical formats by AM News and Public Affairs Director Kathleen Stephenson, who worked at KBOO from 1987 to 2013.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The records of the KBOO Community Radio news and public affairs audio collection consist of radio show broadcast recordings of on-air radio shows, special edited programs created as membership gifts, and raw footage recordings from live events. Other recordings include holdings distributed through the National Federation of Community Broadcasters and produced by other entities such as Pacifica Radio, Alternative Radio, and WRFG.

The collection covers a wide range of broadcast materials including live coverage of news and public affairs, musical and theater performances, and lectures. KBOO's tapes are a vital part of Portland's and Oregon's cultural and political history. KBOO has been at the heart of the action of much of Portland's cultural and political life for almost 5 decades. The KBOO tape archives include exclusive interviews with Oregonians Bob Packwood, Ken Kesey, William Stafford, Gus Van Sant, Ursula Le Guin and Portlander Ben Linder who was murdered by Contras while volunteering in Nicaragua. There are also interviews with national figures like Allen Ginsberg, Native American poet and filmmaker Sherman Alexie, Edward Abbey, Cesar Chavez, Annie Liebovitz, George McGovern, Ramsey Clark, Amory Lovins and hundreds of others. In addition there are live recorded programs documenting marches, demonstrations, community meetings and other events that give 'you are there' discussions with participants and reportage from behind the scenes. Special programs on KBOO history are also represented.
